The clinical service is busy with a large volume of high energy blunt and penetrating traumas. BBS current practice includes 8 orthopaedic surgeons (2 Arthroplasty, 2 Hand, 1 Shoulder/Elbow, 1 Trauma, 1 Trauma/Tumor, 1 Sports), 4 non-operative sports medicine, 1 physiatrist, and 8 nurse practitioners/physician assistants. Also we are actively recruiting an additional orthopaedic trauma surgeon. BBS provides orthopaedic staff and trauma coverage for Memorial Hospital of South Bend, a level II trauma center.
