The oncology service actively manages 30–40 patients at any given time, while also supporting a large population of patients who are off therapy. Additionally, this group receives approximately 200 new hematology referrals annually and provides ongoing care for around 80 children with sickle cell disease, in addition to many others with chronic benign hematologic disorders.

In close collaboration with Riley Children's Health, Beacon's pediatric oncology physicians work seamlessly with a broad network of physician specialists to ensure access to the full spectrum of treatment options. This partnership enhances the depth and breadth of care available to our patients.
